THE GOSPEL OF MATTHEW

Matthew, son of Alphaeus, was a tax collector that Jesus called to leave his work and become one of the twelve disciples. Matthew, who was also known as Levi, spent the next several years living side-by-side with Jesus. He probably wrote his Gospel between AD 60 and 75, to show how Jesus is the fulfilment of Old Testament prophecies about the Messiah.

For centuries, the Israelites expected the Messiah, a Hebrew word literally meaning "anointed one," to be a descendant of King David and return 70 years later.

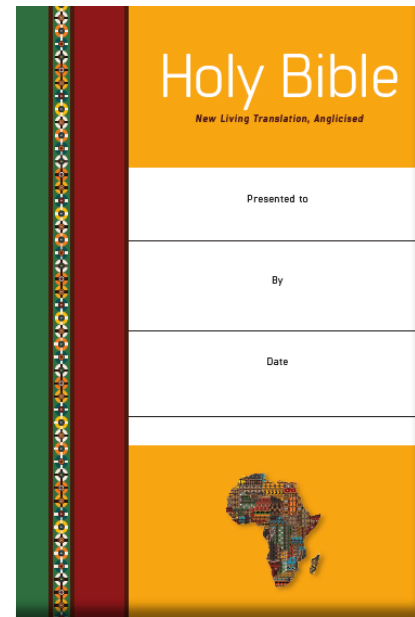
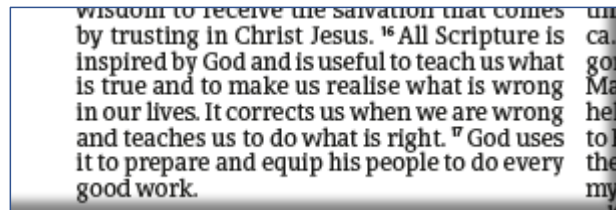

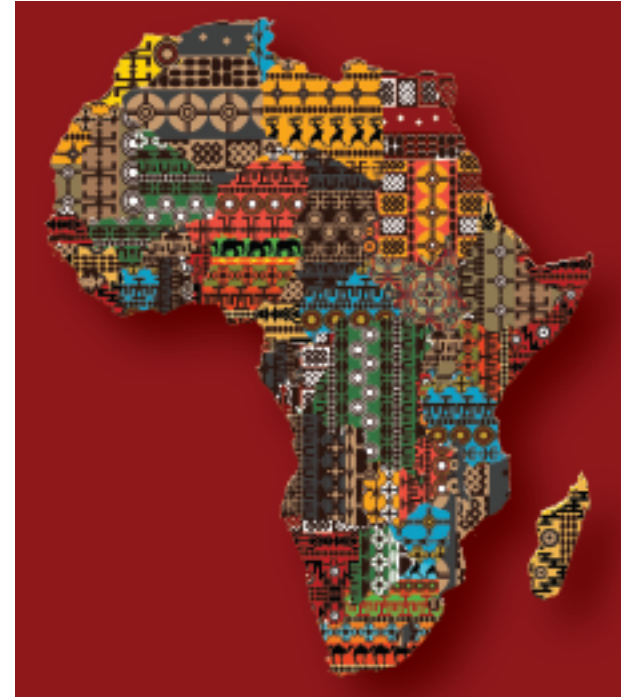
